If you are coming by train it is a ten minute walk from the station. Come out of the main entrance and turn right towards the town centre, you will pass over a bridge. At the main crossroads turn right ,walk for about 5 mins. On your right you will pass the old sorting office (it is closed now) the friends Meeting house is on the opposite side of the road next to Mr and Mrs Smith (a clothes shop)

If you are driving, it is on the A4251, northwest of town centre. Go through the main crossroads, you will come to a small round-about, take the second exit, marked Supermarket car park and this will lead to the long stay car park.

If you are driving you need to park in St Johns Well Lane car park which is the long stay car park.

It is £3.30 for the day and a five minute walk from the Friends meeting House.

The road leading to the car park is almost opposite the venue.

(You can try the roads near the meeting house for free parking, you will have to go into the residential areas though as all the parking in town is restricted.)

Everything else will be provided for you except for an apron, please bring your own if you would like one, but it's not essential. Some previous students have mentioned that they would find a tilting turntable helpful so feel free to bring your own but it is also not essential.
